

We also offer advanced biologic treatment therapy with platelet-rich plasma (PRP) used intra-articularly in combination with stem cell treatments if indicated. Other, more recent drug therapies have become available for treating long


term arthritis, and we look forward to more research and results regarding their efficacy. In chronic severe arthrits cases, salvage surgical options such as joint fusion, partial joint surface resurfacing, and total joint replacement may be indicated and considered. This proactive, tailored approach allows us to address arthritis from multiple angles, supporting long-term joint health and helping our patients enjoy a better quality of life. 
